Hosted our fifth annual Woman in the Outdoors field day, allowing over 85 women an opportunity to learn new outdoor activities. Hosted our fourth annual Wheelin' Sportsmen benefit Ultimate Team Up Dove Hunt and assisted the Adams County chapter with their Wheelin Sportsmen Ultimate Team Up Deer Hunt. River Valley Longbeards continued our support to the Ohio Division of Wildlife with a habitat project located in the East Fork State Park, held our 12<sup>th</sup> annual successful Hunting Heritage Banquet. Our group participated in Turkey Hunters Care program which provided the Clermont County YWCA Food Bank with 108 frozen turkeys for a traditional Thanksgiving meal.
